Relevance of Ranganathan's Approaches to the Modern-Day Information World

About Dr.S.R.Ranganathana

Dr S R Ranganathan is one of the greatest librarians around the globe. He is considered to be the Father of Library Science in India. His birthday is observed every year as "National Librarian's Day" on the 12th August. Dr. S.R. Ranganathan was a mathematician, academician, author, and librarian from India. His fundamental thinking in the field of library science makes him an internationally well-known figure. His major contributions are the Five Laws of Library Science and the development of the first major faceted classification system- the Colon Classification. The Government of India honored him with the Padma Shri in 1957 for his contributions to the field of library science. He was recognized as National Research Professor by the Government of India in 1965 and was awarded with D.Litt. (Honorius Causa) from the University of Delhi in 1948 and the University of Pittsburg, the USA in 1964. He was also recognized as Honorary Vice-President of Library Association, the UK in 1957. The magnificence of his works gave him worldwide recognition and is remembered for his contribution to the librarianship.

Remembering SRR

The Department of Library and Information Science, Central University of Haryana, is commemorating 50 years since the passing away of Padma Shri Dr . S .R. Ranganathan. The year 2022 would be fifty years after his departure from the world. The Department has been organizing yearlong activities to commemorate his contribution, which began on 27 September 2021 with the theme: **LIS Education after Dr. S.R.Ranganathan**. A series of invited talks/

webinars and other activities on the legacies of this great person has taken place to spread the message of his life and teachings, the idea of having courses on him, his works and to strengthen the related areas with him.
